Pursuant to my letter of 27 June enclosed please find questionnaires designed to cover three major refugee solutions:

- Repatriation (arrivals-departures)
- Local integration in countries of asylum
- Resettlement (arrivals-departures)

If any of these are not part of your programme simply state this on page 1, of the appropriate form with a brief explanation.

You will see that many of the questions can be answered by yes or no; easier for you and enough to give a general idea of your work, the details of which will be discussed in Miami. The contents of annexes related to direct services rendered to refugees are, I know, by no means exhaustive. They will however help to give an overall idea of the many tasks your office is called to accomplish in often very difficult circumstances, as well as of your cooperation with other bodies, e.g. through joint projects.

If you have not replied to my first letter as yet please do so by return mail and return the completed questionnaires at your earliest convenience but no later than 1 September - also if you are unable to attend the Consultation. Their purpose is to help us learn more about each other's work and the information would be incomplete without your contributions.

GLOSSARYA. General

1. Units - Persons = family - No. of members. For singles enter: 1-1
2. UNHCR = U.N. High Commissioner for Refugees
3. ICM = Intergovernmental Committee for Migration

B. Assistance rendered by or through your office

1. Temporary local integration: projects for refugees who, although not formally approved for permanent residence have been in the country over 5 years and have few prospects of repatriation or resettlement in 3rd countries.
2. Permanent local integration: projects for refugees approved for permanent residence.
3. Total costs: state only costs covered by or through your office.
4. Funded by: state source of funds expended by your office; e.g. UNHCR, UCC, Danish Refugee Council (DRC), Government(G), Local Churches (LC).

Important: remember to state the US\$ value of local services rendered in kind.

For services which are not funded by or through your office, leave the section "Cost in US\$" blank and under "Funded by" enter who is responsible for the project.

5. Group projects: enter whether agricultural, artisanal, transport, etc.
