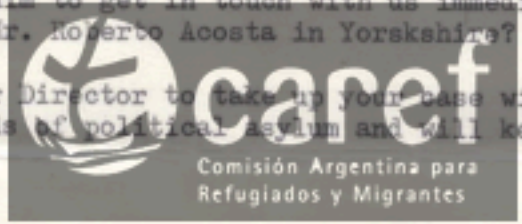
Dear Mr. Reyes Contraras,
