Dear Ms. Peiro,

I am writing to summarize our understanding with regard to your travel and accommodation expenses for the International Consultation on Refugee Women. As we indicated to you in our letter of invitation, we will cover your travel and lodging expenses for the Consultation. Your hotel and meals will be paid directly by us.

With respect to your travel, we have made inquiries in Geneva regarding the possibility of issuing tickets from here. It has become clear, however, that it is generally easier and less expensive to have air flights booked locally. For this reason, it is advisable for you to make your own travel arrangements.

Please save your receipts including those for additional expenses such as visa fees and taxis. Reimbursement for travel costs will be made in US dollars at the Consultation unless you indicate otherwise beforehand.

As we have a limited budget, we ask that in booking your flights you endeavour to take the most direct route possible and take advantage of any special reductions available to you (eg. excursion fares, apex etc.).
