Dear Mr. Cobra,

I have to hand a letter just received from Dr. K.P. Clements of the National Christian Council of New Zealand, which contains the following most welcome information:

"Thank you for your letter of 2nd January.

This is to inform you that the New Zealand Government has accepted our request for another quota and they have once again set the limit at twenty family units. I see no reason why this quota should not be filled from Argentina if this is the country with the most urgent need at the moment. I suggest that you inform your people in Buenos Aires and Lima to contact the New Zealand Embassy, in Argentina the British Embassy, for New Zealand Immigration forms.

It is intended that this group of people be resettled in Auckland. They will receive the same sort of assistance, namely unemployment benefit, English tuition, vocational guidance assistance, and general orientation courses to New Zealand."

Will you please advise possible applicants to contact the British Embassy for registration on appropriate New Zealand registration forms. Also please complete usual WCC Immigration form for every case so registered (dependents over 18 on separate forms). Send original to:
